It was good to see Dan O'Dell in church last Sunday. He moved to the Seattle area last year and was back for a family reunion. He told me that when he got off the plane in Fresno, he exited the airport and felt the Central Valley temperature and sighed, "I am home!" I don't think I have ever had the same reaction to triple digit temperatures. Because Dan lived in the Bakersfield area most of his life, he hasn't yet acclimated to weather in the Pacific Northwest. I said I would like to share a bit of our heat for a bit of their cool, but neither one of us knows how to arrange that. We would have liked to have even a tiny bit of cooler weather at our food distribution last Friday!

In the last Outlook I announced that I was looking for people interested in reviving bell choir, and I have not had one response! It seems that the announcement was a bit premature anyway, because details have not been worked out about how it would happen. But if there is any interest, please let me know so I have your input into the discussion. I will meet with our choir director Doug Carothers on August 2 to discuss plans for the upcoming choir season. I will have more information for you soon afterwards.

We continue our "Re-Shaped" worship series for another three weeks. (Meaning new members are received not from transfers from another UMC or another denomination, but by confessing in public for the first time their faith in Jesus Christ.) Rev. David Samuelson gave credit to the book for bringing so many people to faith. He has not responded to my inquiry about how to construct that kind of worship series, but my plan is to use the book to inspire me. However, it is less expensive from Amazon.)
